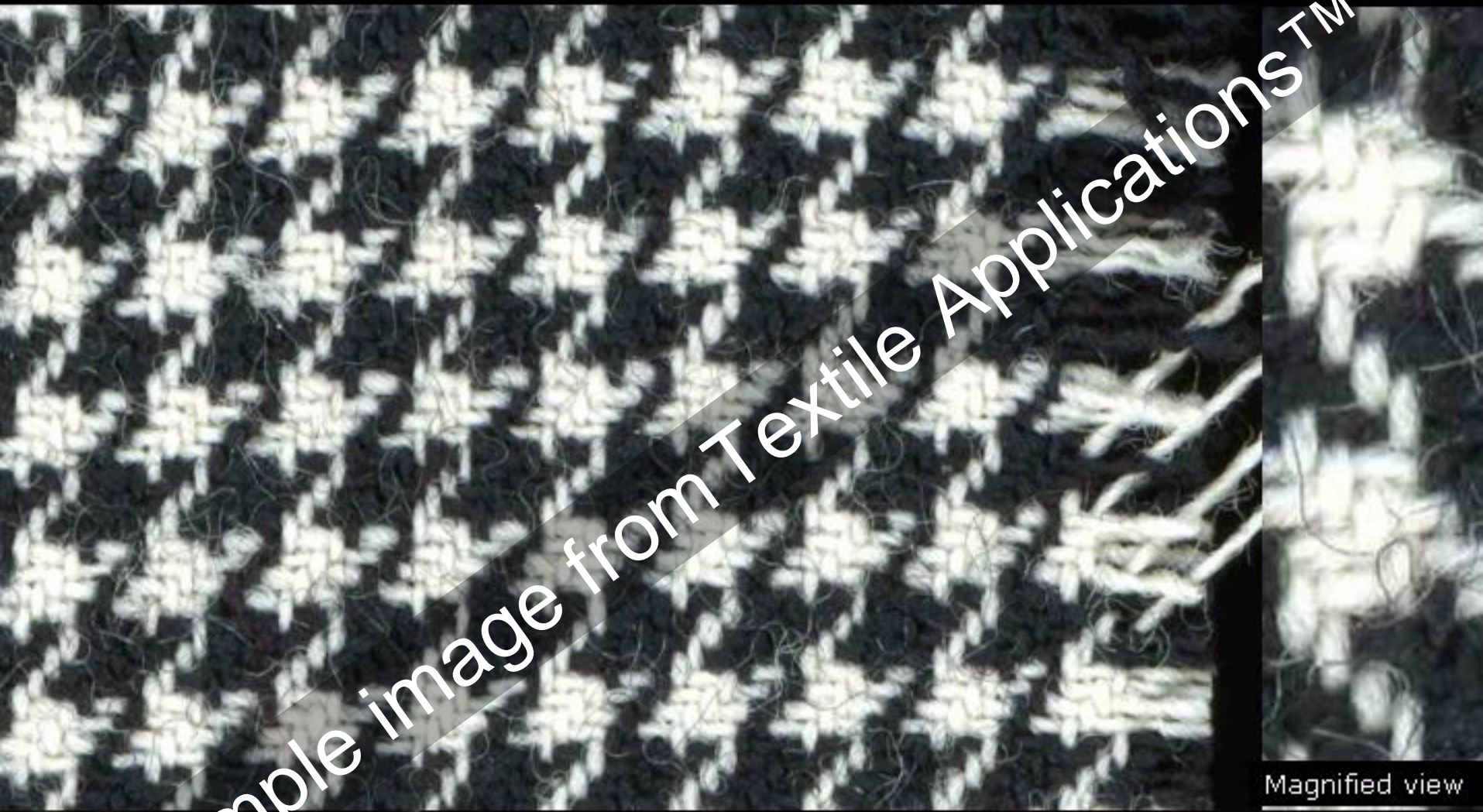


# Houndstooth suiting - Worsted wool spun warp yarn

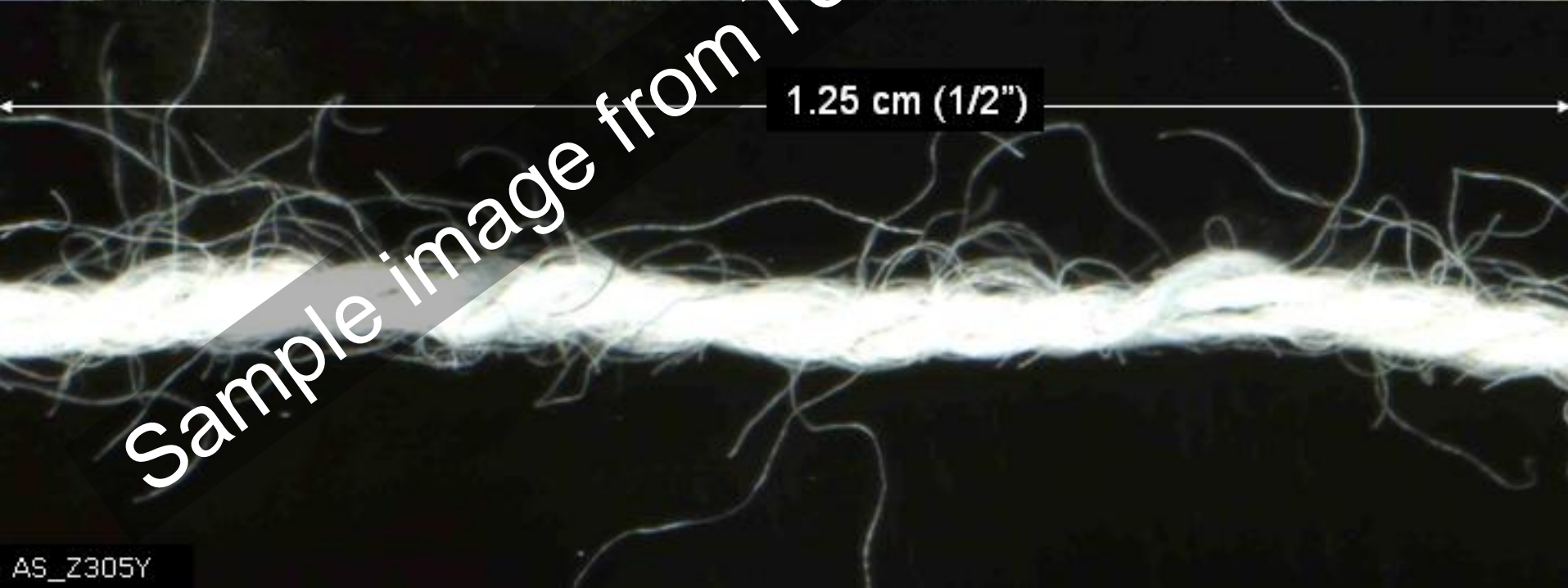

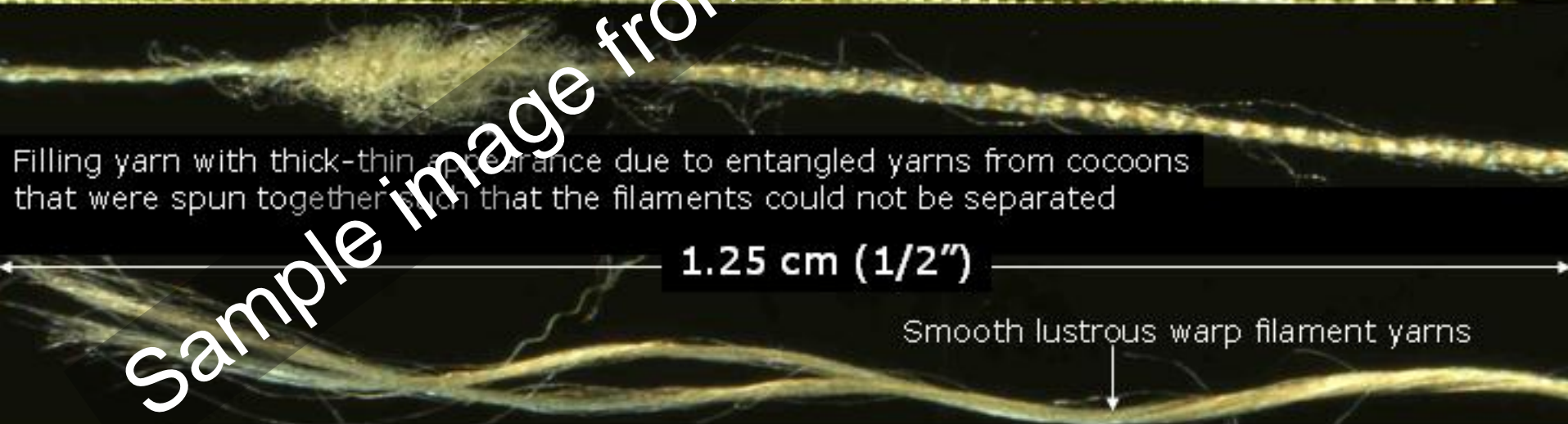

# Doupioni - Silk, multifilament yarn, rib weave



Irregular filling yarns interspersed between yarns that are otherwise regular is characteristic of doupioni silk fabrics



Filling yarn with thick-thin appearance due to entangled yarns from cocoons that were spun together such that the filaments could not be separated

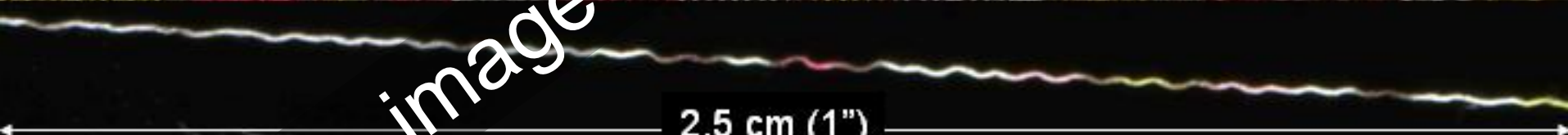

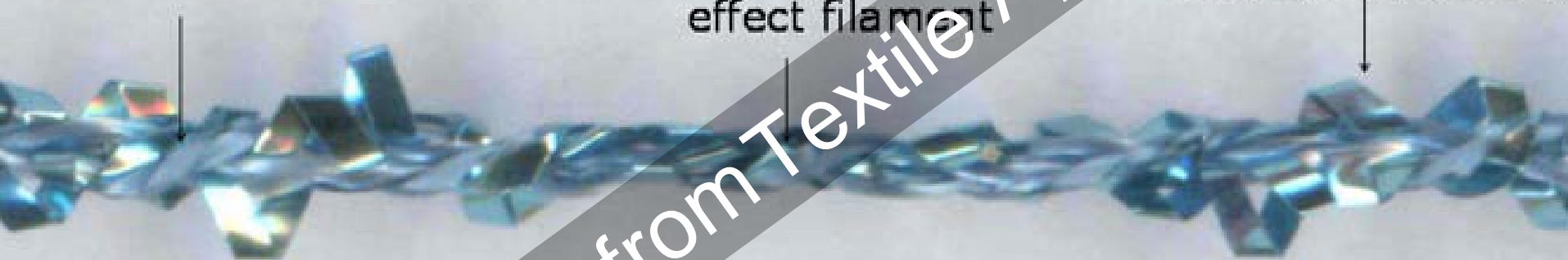
